Basic characteristics of written language and written communication, basic differences between written language and oral language. Lecture: written and oral expression; subjective expression, objective expression; paragraph; paragraph types (introduction-development-conclusion paragraphs). Definition of text and text types (informative texts, literary texts); conditions of textuality (cohesion, consistency, purposefulness, acceptability, situationally, informativeness, intertextual relations). Written expression (written composition: free writing, planned writing); planned writing stages (subject, limitation of subject, aim, point of view, determination of main and side thoughts, preparation of writing plan, paper layout); theoretical information on informative texts (petition, letter, news, decision, announcement/advertisement, minutes, reports, official letters, scientific writings); working on examples and writing applications; summarizing and charting a text; correcting language and expression mistakes in written applications.
