

Turkish II: Oral Expression (2-0) 2

Basic features of oral language and verbal communication. Verbal lecture; basic features of speech skill (using natural language and body language); basic principles of speaking well; basic features of a good speaker (emphasis, intonation, pause, diction, etc.). Unprepared and prepared speech; the stages of prepared speaking (selection and limitation of the subject, purpose, point of view, determination of main and side thoughts, planning, writing the text, presentation of speech). Types of conversation: (duologues, commune, self-introduction, responding to questions, celebrating an important event such as New Year, birth, feast, etc., giving directions, talking on the phone, asking for work, interviewing with someone, talks on the radio and television, participation in various culture and art programs as a speaker, etc.). Making unprepared speeches on different topics, working on examples of speech and verbal expression practices, correcting the language and expression mistakes in the speeches.
